- Arrange talks by counselors and higher officials
- Arranging contact information of contact persons
- To maintain vigil, oversight, undertake patrolling functions and to remain mobile, alert and active at all times in the Institute.
- To make surprise raids in the concerned hostels and other vulnerable places where students
 generally visit and where either the incidents of ragging have occurred or which are
 potentially prone to ragging.
- To conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it the Principal or Anti Ragging Coordinator or any member of the faculty or any-member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be.
