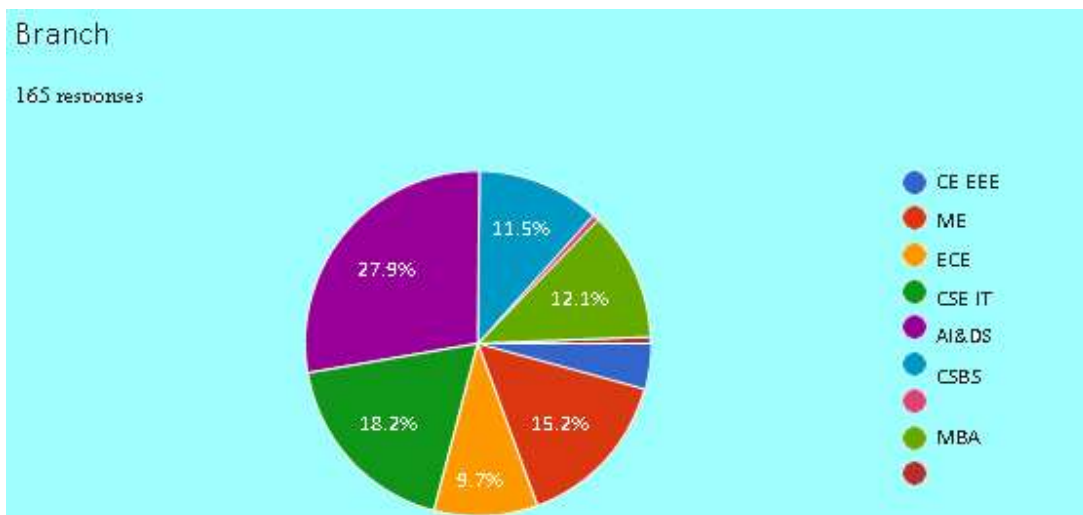
YOGA DAY CELEBRATIONS:
